Judge Jones was appointed to the bench in 1996 by President Clinton. Prior to his appointment he was engaged in the private practice of law, primarily as a civil litigator. He is a graduate of Duke University and the University of Virginia Law School and is a former state senator and president of the State Board of Education. He was the chief judge of the district.

The Western District of Virginia covers a large geographical area, with courthouses at seven places in the district. Judge Jones' chambers are located in the federal courthouse in Abingdon, Virginia, a town of 7,500 located in southwest Virginia, near the Tri-Cities metropolitan region of Bristol-Kingsport-Johnson City, Tennessee.
