

**Instruction No. \_\_\_\_\_**

Members of the jury, the evidence and arguments in this case have been completed. It is your duty to determine the facts from the evidence. Then you are to apply the law as given in the instructions of the court to the facts and in this way decide the case. Regardless of any opinion you may have as to what the law ought to be, you must not question any rule of law as the court announces it. You may not single out any one instruction as stating the law, but you must consider the instructions as a whole and follow each one.

In deciding the facts of this case you must not be swayed by bias or prejudice or favor as to any party. Our system of law does not permit jurors to be governed by prejudice or sympathy or public opinion. Both the parties and the public expect that you will carefully and impartially consider all of the evidence in the case, follow the law as stated by the court, and reach a just verdict regardless of the consequences.
