Upon motion of the United States of America, by counsel, to establish a grand jury panel to begin serving in April, 2007 in the Harrisonburg Division of this Court and for good cause shown, it is hereby

ORDERED

that the Clerk of the Court shall draw 225 grand jurors from the Qualified Wheel of the Harrisonburg Division selected from lists of registered voters in that division. Those drawn for grand jury service shall be notified that they may be summoned for grand jury service. The Clerk shall then draw at random a sufficient number as determined to be needed and from which a panel of not more than 23 jurors shall be selected. Those persons selected may be summoned to serve as members of the grand jury for a period of twelve months or more.
