STANDING ORDER NO. 2020-1

IT APPEARING to the Court that the Plan for Composition, Administration, and Management of Private Attorneys under the Criminal Justice Act for the United States District Court for the Western District of Virginia, as approved on July 3, 2018, provides for the establishment of a Panel Selection Advisory committee, whose duties are as set forth in the said Plan;

AND IT APPEARING that the Internal Operational Guidelines for the Criminal Justice Act Advisory Committee provide that the Chief Judge of the Court has the duty and authority to appoint one Criminal Justice Act panel member from each of the divisions of the Court to serve together with the Clerk of the Court and the Federal Public Defender for the District;


