REAPPOINTMENT OF INCUMBENT MAGISTRATE JUDGE

The current term of office of United States Magistrate Judge Pamela Meade Sargent at Abingdon is due to expire on December 14, 2013. The United States District Court is required by law to establish a panel of citizens to consider the reappointment of the magistrate judge to a new eight-year term.

The duties of a magistrate judge in this court include the following:

- Conducting most preliminary proceedings in criminal cases;
- Trying and disposing of misdemeanor cases;
- Conducting various pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings on delegation from a district judge; and
- Trying and disposing of civil cases upon consent of the litigants.
