To assist the courts in determining reasonable hourly rates to be paid to frequently used service providers, the national hourly rate ranges in CJA cases are reviewed periodically by the Judicial Conference of the United States, Committee on Defender Services, and by the Fourth Circuit Judicial Council. These hourly rate ranges are published and updated when necessary by the Committee and Fourth Circuit. Therefore, Standing Order No. 2011-13, setting forth the hourly rate ranges for CJA counsel, paralegals, investigators, mitigation specialists, jury consultants, and law students, is unnecessary.

Accordingly, Standing Order No. 2011-13 of this court is hereby  
VACATED.
