

IN RE: AMENDMENT OF THIRD YEAR PRACTICE RULE

STANDING ORDER NO. 06-04

The Third Year Practice Rule, adopted by Order entered July 10, 1974, is hereby amended as follows:

Paragraph II (A) currently requires the law student to be duly enrolled in this State in a law school approved by the American Bar Association. Hereafter, such provision shall read as follows:

“Be duly enrolled in a law school approved by the American Bar Association or the Virginia Board of Bar Examiners.”
