ORDER


WHEREAS it has been determined by this Judicial Council that the services of a retired bankruptcy judge are needed for the Fourth Circuit, and

WHEREAS William F. Stone, Jr., has retired from service effective January 2, 2014, and consented to serve as a recalled bankruptcy judge pursuant to the regulations promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS ORDERED pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 155(b) that William F. Stone, Jr. is recalled into service as a United States Bankruptcy Judge to serve in the Western District of Virginia at Roanoke for a term effective January, 3, 2015 not to exceed January 3, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT William F. Stone, Jr. shall receive, in addition to any annuity he is entitled to under the applicable provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 377 or section 2(c) of Pub. L. 100-659 (excluding any offset under 5 U.S.C. § 8440b(b)(8)), an amount equal to the difference between that annuity and the current salary of a full-time bankruptcy judge.
