STANDING ORDER No. 2024-10

In accordance with Judicial Conference policy that allows limited refund authority for electronically paid fees, this Court hereby adopts the following procedures to refund fees that are paid electronically in error.

- 1. This refund authority applies only when user error causes duplicate payments and erroneous payments in the court's CM/ECF filing system.
- 2. The CM/ECF user who erred in making payment must submit an application to the Clerk of Court explaining the error in payment and requesting a refund. This application is posted to the Court's public website under the Forms tab.
- 3. The Chief Judge has delegated to the Clerk the authority to approve a refund of duplicate and erroneously paid fees.
- 4. Refunds will be processed only through the electronic credit card system.
- In the event that a particular attorney or law firm continues to make repeated mistakes
 when submitting fees and requesting refunds, the Court may consider remedial action,
 such as issuing an order to show cause why further requests for refunds should be
 considered.
