ORDERED

Those drawn for grand jury service shall be notified that they may be summoned for grand jury service. The Clerk shall then draw at random a sufficient number as determined to be needed and from which a panel of not more than 23 jurors shall be selected. Those persons selected may be summoned to serve as members of the grand jury for a period of twelve months or more.
