Pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act, 18, U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(1) and (c), and the discretion of the Court, the Federal Public Defender for the Western District of Virginia is appointed to represent any defendant sentenced in this district who was previously determined to have been entitled to appointment of counsel, or who is now indigent, to determine whether that defendant may qualify for relief under Amendment 821 to the United States Sentencing Guidelines.

The United States Probation Office for the Western District of Virginia is directed to provide the Federal Public Defender, the United States Attorney, and the court with a list of defendants potentially eligible for sentence reduction pursuant to Amendment 821. The Probation Office and the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Western District of Virginia are authorized to disclose Presentence Investigation Reports, Statement of Reasons and Judgments to the Federal Public Defender for the purpose of determining eligibility for relief under Amendment 821.
