

STANDING ORDER

Pursuant to the provisions of the Criminal Justice Act, Title 18, U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(1) and (c), and the discretion of the Court, the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Western District of Virginia is hereby appointed to represent any defendant sentenced in this district who was previously determined to have been entitled to appointment of counsel or who is now indigent, to determine whether that defendant may qualify for federal habeas relief under either 28 U.S.C. § 2255 or 28 U.S.C. § 2241 in light of *Johnson v. United States*, __ U.S. __, 2015 WL 2473450 (June 26, 2015).

The U.S. Probation Office for the Western District of Virginia and the United States District Court Clerk's Office for the Western District of Virginia are authorized to disclose Presentence Investigation Reports, Statements of Reasons, and Judgments to the Federal Public Defender's Office for the purpose of determining eligibility for relief under *Johnson*.
